



Summer School Blended Learning in Higher and Professional Education

July 25th to August 12th 2016. Leiden, The Netherlands

What is it about?

The Leiden Summer School is organised for professionals who want to learn how to apply a Blended Learning method in their educational practice. The Summer School is organized by ICLON, Graduate School of Teaching, Leiden University and Dutch Academic Services. It will take place at Leiden University, in the beautiful town of Leiden.

Our Training

In Blended Learning face to face class sessions are alternated by activities of students and teachers in an online learning environment.

During three weeks the Summer School will offer participants a wide range of strategies, hands on experience and tools for implementing Blended Learning at their own institutions. Participants produce their own Blended Learning training materials, but will also work on an organizational change project for their own institute or department. All work done will be supported with theoretical models, practical tools and tailor made solutions by peers, instructors and guest speakers.

Programme

The course is demand driven, hence the actual content of the Summer School will strongly depend on the questions and projects of the participants. The course itself will have a Blended Learning design, which means participants are requested to do work prior to the course and make assignments during the course. After the course they have an action plan for implementing new or improved programmes at home.

The Summer School is offered by highly trained and experienced professionals who are working in Higher and professional Education in the Netherlands. Moreover they have ample international experience. See overleaf for the framework of the programme.



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Goals of the training

At the end of the training participants:

- Will have a concise and practical overview of the major learning and instructional design theories related to a Blended Learning approach.
- Will have received training in the use of an optimal mix of tools and applications which can be applied in a Blended Learning setting.
- Will have designed and developed blended formats for their domestic curricula and course programs. These products will be platform independent or will be geared to the particular platform that is used by the participants' organization.
- Will have drafted an institutional or departmental development plan regarding the introduction or re-enforcement of Blended Learning.
- Will have built their own international professional community around Blended Learning.

Week 1

Introduction to Blended Learning theories and practices.

The training will consist of lectures, hands on training and study assignments.

Week 2

Blended Learning tools and strategies.

Guest lectures, hands on training and project design.

Week 3

Blended Learning in your own institution

Practical curriculum and lesson design. Blended Learning project implementation.

At the end of the course participants will receive a Leiden University and Dutch Academic Services training certificate.
